TEMPLATE COVID-19 RISK ASSESSMENT

What is COVID-19?

Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) is a respiratory illness that affects your lungs and airways. It is caused by a virus called Coronavirus and affected individuals can display a range of symptoms from mild to severe illness and death for confirmed cases. Affected people can also be entirely asymptomatic. Transmission is by respiratory droplets and direct contact. This Risk Assessment template must be considered alongside current Government guidance.

Action for Event Organisers

- 1. Complete this Covid 19 risk assessment. You can use this template and add risks and remove them to suit the event you are organising.
- 2. Also complete the normal H & S Risk Assessment.
- 3. Register your event on HASSRA Live and ensure all members complete the application on HASSRA Live prior to the event.
- 4. Circulate Government Guidelines prior to any event. Here is the link https://www.gov.uk/coronavirus
- 5. Remind participants of the Government Guidelines and all Covid 19 special arrangements in briefing before event commences.
- 6. Tell participants that they must inform you, the Event Organiser if they test positive for Covid 19 during the 10 days after the event.
- 7. If any participant tests positive within 10 days of the event inform all participants so they can follow current guidance on testing and isolating.
