Have you moved office location?

Are your contact details correct in HASSRA Live?

With a number of recent site closures and with colleagues changing job roles and locations, it's important that you keep your location details up to date in HASSRA Live.

You can view your location details in HASSRA Live by taking the following steps:

- Log into your HASSRA Live account
- Click on the silhouette image in the top right hand corner next to your name and the 'sign out' option
- Select 'My Profile'
- Under the 'Your Membership Information' check the field titled 'Full Office Address' accurately reflects your current office location.
- If it doesn't you will need to select the 'Update your membership' link and then select 'Make an Enquiry' at the bottom of the screen.
- Type in the details of your enquiry, including the full address of your new location and the HASSRA National Team will update your details.

Keeping your personal details up to date is important to ensure that you are assigned to the correct HASSRA club, are eligible to enter local competitions and events and also ensures your local club receives the correct rebate which helps to fund activities and events in your local office. Don't delay, please check your details today and update your HASSRA account if the information is incorrect.

Recruit & Reward Club Challenge Results

The HASSRA West Midlands 'Recruit & Reward Club Challenge' 2023 took place between 01/08/2023 and 31/12/2023, with the aim of encouraging local HASSRA clubs to recruit new members in return for a financial reward.

End of Year Club Accounts & Rebates

The HASSRA West Midlands Regional Board of Management have agreed a number of important changes to end of year accounts and rebates for 2024. These changes have been introduced as a result of non compliance and challenges to receive end of year club accounts on time.

The following key changes have been communicated to Club Officials:

- For a club to receive a 2024 rebate, they will need to:
 - Have the 2023 accounts fully audited and uploaded to HASSRA Live.
 - Have held the Annual General Meeting (at which the accounts are presented).
 - Upload a fully completed Chair Certificate to HASSRA Live.

Both the audited accounts <u>and</u> a fully completed Chair certificate will need to be uploaded to HASSRA Live for a membership rebate to be paid.

Changes to the timescales for submitting end of year accounts have also been agreed.

- Clubs will receive a rebate based on submitting accounts within the following timescales:
 - ♦ 100% rebate for accounts received by 31/03/2024.
 - ♦ 50% rebate for accounts submitted between 01/04/2024 and 31/07/2024.
 - ♦ 0% rebate for accounts submitted after 01/08/2024.

The HASSRA West Midlands Regional Finance Policy has been amended to ensure that all financial governance is completed in a timely manner and to ensure we are consistent with the expectations set out in the DWP Staff Clubs Guide.
