  existing interest and potential to go on and do more. Examples in this category include sports
  (including coaching and refereeing), arts and crafts.
- Volunteering & Community developing your potential to serve HASSRA or your local community where you can show you have an existing interest and potential to go on and do more. Examples in this category include life skills coaching, youth worker, scout or guide leader, and so on.

HASSRA member Osian Hughes, based at Oswestry Jobcentre is taking part in a Cycle 1,000 fundraiser between July and September to raise money for Cancer Research UK. Osian is back on his bike after raising £862.94 in 2019 for Cancer Research, only this year he's setting himself an increased target of cycling 1,000 miles to raise £1,000 for charity.

Osian said, "I have been pondering what to do this year to be different from last as doing the same thing is no longer a challenge. I was overwhelmed by the donations and sponsorship received last year, it far exceeded what I thought I could raise. During COVID-19 lockdown I took advantage of the quieter roads and used the time to improve my cycling ability. Then along came the HASSRA Cycling Challenge, it inspired me to make an immediate start on my week's leave, I decided 1,000 miles was a nice sounding benchmark, with work and home commitments I want to achieve this within 3 months. I want to beat last year's challenge,
