West Midlands Annual General Meeting 2020

The 2020 HASSRA West Midlands Annual General Meeting took place via Microsoft Teams on Thursday 11th March 2021.

The meeting was hosted by West Midlands Regional Chair Andy Richmond. In Andy's opening address he thanked everyone for their support of HASSRA during what has undoubtedly been the most difficult and challenging 12 months of the association's history. With the regional programme of activities and sporting events curtailed, budgets were reallocated with the region spending over £10,000 on competitions with the intention of 'less for more' – less high value prizes, spread across more winners. The Annual Report details the huge numbers of winners in competitions and giveaways.
