HASSRA Men's Hockey – Hancock & Evans 2023

The HASSRA Men's national hockey side travelled to Nottingham to compete in the annual Hancock & Evans tournament held at Beeston Hockey Club.

The tournament which is held across 2 days brings together teams and players representing a number of areas of the Civil Service from all across the country for friendly but competitive hockey with the opportunity for teams to win the cup or the plate following a league round robin on day 1. The tournament also acts as a 'scouting event' to identify potential players for the CSSC Rep team, who compete against the Armed Services each year.

With HASSRA missing a number of players due to unavailability and being drawn in a league with last years cup finalists, the first day was a struggle for the side with heavy defeats in 2 games leaving the team third in the group.

However, not feeling demoralised the team vowed to regroup with the aim of winning the plate tournament as they had successfully done in 2021 and 2022.

On day 2 a rejuvenated HASSRA side significantly improved their performance in their final 2 games, ensuring HASSRA were crowned winners of the plate for the third year running.

During the presentation the team picked up further recognition with Lawrence Payne receiving the Sportsmanship award from the organisers of the event and Paul Atherton winning the Player of the Tournament after receiving the most votes from the umpires officiating the games over the 2 days.

The CSSC National Team Squash Event again returned to the popular Nottingham Squash Club which is now under new management. This year HASSRA fielded an even stronger line up than last year entering three teams in an attempt to retain the title they had won last year. Last year's runners-up North West however had arrived with a strengthened team in the form of a new number one player and had plans of their own to steal the title away from HASSRA.



However, what they hadn't bargained for was a further strengthened set of HASSRA players and better still for HASSRA A team to have their own new number one player, ex professional James Earles, who is currently ranked 40 in the England Squash rankings and in the top 200 of the world!

The final between HASSRA A and North West saw the two strongest players in the Tournament face each other, HASSRA A triumphant with a 5-0 match score and impressively none of the A team losing a single match!

HASSRA B led by experienced captain Peter Fielding continued to highlight HASSRA overall success story by defeating HASSRA C in the Plate Final.



Team Manager Siân Hughes was delighted with the wins and thankful for being able to assemble such strong line ups to win both the Main Event and the Plate Competition. Special thanks go to all the players who participated and in particular to James Earles who's first outing for HASSRA hopefully won't be his last!
