2020 promises to be a wonderful year. With the Tokyo Games just around the corner, this issue has an Olympic theme running throughout.



HASSRA Live Update

Following the launch of HASSRA Live in October, more than 50% of members have already activated their personal accounts and this figure continues to steadily rise. If you've not already done so, activate your account and subscribe to our newsletters now.

We have introduced a number of security features to ensure your data remains safe from attack whilst also providing the necessary assurances required by our benefit partners.

This includes raising the level of password protection. If your current password does not meet our new standards, you will be prompted to change your password when you next sign in. The system will check your new password and, if necessary, provide prompts to ensure it complies with the new format.

Three failed attempts to log-in will result in you being temporarily locked out of your account. It is therefore imperative that you choose a memorable password that meets the new criteria.

In summary, your new password must be at least 8 characters in length and contain:

- at least one capital letter
- at least one lower case letter
- at least one number
- at least one special symbol, such as @?%!£ etc.

Your new password must not contain - or be based on - a dictionary word or name.

The following examples will give you an idea of how to create a password that will satisfy the criteria and also be memorable.

H&5sra1234 (alternative to HASSRA) W1nt£r2020 (alternative to Winter) R088i£2468 (alternative to Robbie) J&Cki£2020 (alternative to Jackie)

Remember, these are examples and not for general use.

By taking these steps you will get the most from your membership and be ready for the next phase of the rollout which will include event organisation and registration, expenses and competitions. Watch this space for full details.

Doing it for the kids!

HASSRA clubs have a fantastic reputation for fundraising and many have a chosen charity that they raise funds for each year.

St Martins House in Bootle, (HASSRA North West) is no different. In 2019, their chosen charity was Ronald McDonald House. Located near Alder Hey Children's Hospital, it is the UK's largest Ronald McDonald House with running costs of £700,000 per year, providing accommodation for up to 84 families of children receiving hospital treatment.

The club raised more than £650 for the charity throughout the year, as well as donating Easter Eggs and Advent Calendars for the children and their families, but they didn't stop there...

Through DWPs Community 10,000 volunteering scheme, members of the club committee and some staff from the office volunteered for a day at Ronald McDonald House. They were certainly kept busy; sorting out stock, tidying store rooms, painting and decorating, gardening and general maintenance. Their efforts equated to savings of £650 in time and resources for the charity.

This was a great way to provide practical support for the charity and really helped the volunteers to see how their fundraising was going to help. It really inspired the group to carry on fundraising for such a worthwhile charity.

Keen swimmer's Olympic dream

Megan Keen (HASSRA London) recently received HASSRA
Development Fund support to help her with the cost of competing at the National Swimming Championships with the aim of eventually making the Olympic Trials for Tokyo 2020.

Megan took two titles in the 200m Backstroke and 200m Individual Medley (IM) at the Sussex County Championships, and an array of silver and bronze, leading up to the Nationals in Sheffield Ponds Forge where she went on to scoop two National titles in the 200m Backstroke and 400m IM, as well as silver in the 100m Butterfly and bronze in the 100m IM and 50m Butterfly.

This was closely followed by the Inter-County Championships where, in the South East region, Sussex won the team event and Megan won her individual race and all her relays.

We all wish Megan the best of luck in building on her recent success and fulfilling her Olympic dream.


Throughout the year, HASSRA regularly features Fun & Free competitions, ballots and giveaways with a range of fantastic prizes for our members.

Help us help others



We helped Umme many years ago. Still learning how to cope with the grief of losing a child, she now feels ready to tell her story.

Umme started working for the Civil Service in 2005. As a young, driven woman, she worked hard to progress within the Department for Work and Pensions. In addition to having a successful career, Umme also wanted a family. When she eventually fell pregnant, she gave birth to a baby girl and named her Hamidah. She was just 23 weeks into her pregnancy.

Although the doctors did everything they could to save Hamidah's life, she tragically passed away just three days later. In the Muslim community, it's tradition to bury deceased loved ones as soon as possible and therefore funeral plans had to be made quickly.

"She died on the Saturday and we were able to bury her on the Sunday. Luckily, the people who worked at the mosque said we could pay the funeral costs later but we were already struggling financially. We just couldn't afford it."

Umme's work friends wanted to help and suggested she get in touch with the Charity. After a supportive conversation with our team, we found that we were able to provide financial support to the family during this difficult time. Umme and her husband finally had the space to rebuild the world around them after saying goodbye to their baby girl.

"I needed to feel like someone was there for me and that's exactly how the Charity made me feel. It's important to share my story if it means I can help other people. I want to give back to the Charity in whatever way I can."
